He stated that with the hiring of Single Role EMS Staff would like to see the Single Roles be provided the same opportunity to transition to the firefighter classification right along with the volunteers that have been in good standing with MCFR and has been a volunteer for 1 year. He stated the reason why this has come up is because we have lost a dual-role firefighter. A discussion followed regarding single roles versus dual roles.

A brief discussion followed. Commissioner Chair stated he would entertain a motion. Commissioner Hutchison made a motion to approve the testing and assessment process as outlined on the Information sheet to establish an eligibility register from which to fill current and future firefighter vacancies. Commissioner Willer seconded. Commissioner Chair Covert asked for a vote; 3 Ayes, 0 Nays. Motion carried.

Commission Chair Covert asked about the Google buildings and if they will depreciate. A brief discussion followed. Chief Palmer also discussed with the Commissioners the ISO rating, stating if we were to be fully staffed MCFR's ISO rating would go from a 3 to a 2 which would be a good thing for all taxpayers in lowering their insurance rates.
